All Wayne State University medical students are eligible to submit abstracts on a research project to which they have made a significant contribution. Students who participated in a Medical Student Summer Research Fellowship in 2023 are expected to submit abstracts of their work.

Please note:

- All presentations will be *Poster Format*.
- The symposium is limited to *one* abstract submission per medical student.
- Case reports do not meet the requirements for a formal research project and will not be accepted.

We are eager to have all students participate who have research work to share!

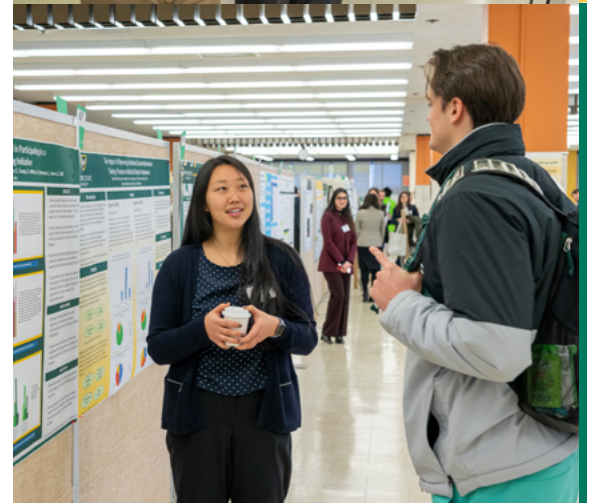
SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS
